Avoid Duplicate Content: Ensure your content is unique and not plagiarized from other websites. Be mindful of how articles are categorized to prevent unintentional duplication.

2. User Experience and Site Structure:

Easy Navigation: Your site should be easy to navigate with a clear and logical structure.

Fast Loading Speed: Optimize your site for speed to provide a good user experience. Tools like Google PageSpeed Insights can help with this.

Mobile-Friendly Design: Ensure your site is responsive and displays well on all devices.

Mandatory Pages: Include essential pages such as a Privacy Policy, Terms of Service, and a Contact Us page.

3. Technical Compliance:

SSL Certificate: Secure your site with an SSL certificate (HTTPS).

Compliance with Webmaster Guidelines: Adhere to Google's Webmaster Guidelines, which are integral to AdSense policies.

4. AdSense Policy Compliance:

Review AdSense Program Policies: Thoroughly understand and comply with all AdSense Program policies regarding prohibited content, traffic sources, and ad placement.
